**CALL TO ORDER**

Mr. Carey, as President, declared this to be a legal meeting of the Board of Education.

**ROLL CALL**

Those Board Members in attendance and answering roll call were: Mr. Brown, Mr. Carey, Mr. McDevitt, Mr. Kofoet, Mrs. Muller, Mr. Schott, Mr. Stargell. Mr. O'Brien arrived at 7:05 P.M., Mr. Dobson was absent.

Also in attendance were Dr. Chapman, Superintendent of Schools, Mr. Yacovelli, School Business Administrator/Board Secretary, Mr. Oliver, Director of Elementary, Mr. Taylor, Director of Personnel.

A motion was made by Mr. McDevitt and seconded by Mr. Kofoet to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of Personnel matters. The motion was approved by a unanimous voice vote (8-0-0).

The Board entered into Executive Session at 7:03 P.M. Mr. Stargell left the meeting during Executive Session at 9:08 P.M.

A motion was made by Mrs. Muller and seconded by Mr. Brown to return to Public Session at 9:15 P.M. The motion was approved by a unanimous voice vote (7-0-0).
