After a disappointing 42-35 week 7 loss to Camden Catholic, Coach Clinton Tabb was able to get the BIG RED up for the next two games, both convincing wins, 40-8 over Wash. Twn. and 33-7 over Eastern. The two wins

raised the season record to 7-1 and earned the INDIANS the #1 seed in the upcoming NJSIAA State Football playoffs. The BIG RED will host 8th seed Atlantic City this Saturday at 1:00pm. A victory will move PHS into the semifi-

nals on Sat. Nov. 19th also at home vs. the winner of the Southern-Triton matchup.

Senior Quarterback Manny Cortez continues to dazzle South Jersey defenses and cause supporters and opponents alike to say "wow!"

Manny has thrown for 29 touchdowns this sea-

son, the most thrown in over ten years among South Jersey high school quarterbacks. The SJ record is 40, a mark that is not out of his reach, especially if the BIG RED continues to win in the state

playoffs. In 8 games, Manny has completed 62% of his passes for 2,114 yards. He has also rushed for 655 yards and completed passes to 8 different teammates. Amar Williams is the favorite target with 35 catches and 11 TD's.

FIELD HOCKEY RECORD BEST IN 16 YEARS

It was not enough to qualify for the State playoffs for the PHS Field Hockey team, accumulating wins and shut-outs was a trademark as well. The 2011 BIG RED won 12

games this season, the most since 1995. After finishing 2nd in the league standings behind state powerhouse Shawnee, the INDIANS moved into the state playoffs as the #2 seed. With a
