## Rules and Procedures:

### Possible Themes

- Single Stream Recycling
- Why recycle?
- What does recycling do for the community?
- The science of recycling
- Impact of recycling on the environment

All artwork must be original. Students may work in pairs. Names, school, grade and classroom teacher should be printed on the back of the poster. Posters must be done on 8.5"x11", and must be landscape layout.

### Judging criteria

- Clear message is conveyed by text/art
- Poster theme is addressed
- Creativity, originality, artistic quality
- Visual clarity—easily read
- Bright and colorful

**Each classroom teacher will submit 3 classroom winners to a building committee who will choose 1-2 winners, per grade, per school.**
