**CALL TO ORDER**

Advanced written notice of this meeting of the Pennsauken Township Board of Education was sent to the Courier Post stating the time, date, location and that formal action would be taken at that time. Notice was also posted with the Township Clerk, Pennsauken Public Library, Pennsauken High School, Pennsauken Administration Building and Pennsauken Schools website.

Mr. O'Brien as President, declared this to be a legal meeting of the Board of Education.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

The Pennsauken Township Board of Education recognizes that the schools are the concern of all members of the community. July 1, 2012 - -June 30, 2013 -	\$162,500.00
July 1, 2013 - June 30, 2014 -	\$165,000.00
July 1, 2014- - June 30, 2015 -	\$167,500.00

Mrs. Martinez gave a short acceptance speech.
